
4-H RECORD BOOKS & PUBLIC DEMONSTRATIONS 4-H AND FFA FLOWERS

- Members may enter project records for all projects they are enrolled in. Project records shall be complete to date of fair entry and signed by the 4H leader.
- Please put all records in one book.
- Please enter one book complete with all the records.
- The book may be hard or soft cover.
- One ribbon per book.
- Refer to the Score sheet for Judging Guidelines, which is available in the Extension office.
- Primary members are encouraged to enter record books; however, judging will not be on a competitive basis.
- Participatory recognition will be given to primary 4H members.
- 4H Record Books are due by 5pm the third Monday in August and need to be turned into the WSU/Whitman County Extension Office.
- Books will be judged prior to the fair and then exhibited at the fair.
