General Rules & Information

All contest guides are available online at http://pubs.wsu.edu. Then search horse contest guides. Please be familiar with them prior to the Fair.

- Entries in 4-H and FFA divisions must be recongnized projects in member's care by June 1st of the current year.
- 2. Entry Forms must be signed by club leader or FFA instructor, exhibitor and parent/guardian and mailed by August 1. They must also include an exhibitor number.
- 3. NO stallions.
- 4. 4H and FFA may not cross entries.
- 5. Premium points will be given to all participants in Fitting and Showing, and one entry in each of the following; Div 2, Div 4, and Div 5, for a total of 4 class entries, but may participate in more.
- 6. All divisions will be judged according to the danish system, with premium points as follows: Blue- 80, Red-50, and White-20.
- 7. Age Groups (by grade completed)
- 8. All exhibits will be placed by 8pm Wednesday and are not to be taken out until after 4:01 pm Sunday.

- 3. Additional tests as directed by judge.

DIV 2 - Western Games

HORSE GROOM SQUAD


Special Awards Given
