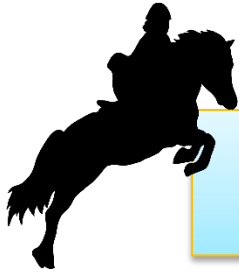

### General Rules & Information

All contest guides are available online at <http://pubs.wsu.edu>. Then search horse contest guides. Please be familiar with them prior to the Fair.

1. Entries in 4-H and FFA divisions must be recongnized projects in member's care by June 1<sup>st</sup> of the current year.
2. Entry Forms must be signed by club leader or FFA instructor, exhibitor and parent/guardian and mailed by August 1. They must also include an exhibitor number.
3. NO stallions.
4. 4H and FFA may not cross entries.
5. Premium points will be given to all participants in Fitting and Showing, and one entry in each of the following; Div 2, Div 4, and Div 5, for a total of 4 class entries, but may participate in more.
6. All divisions will be judged according to the danish system, with premium points as follows: Blue- 80, Red-50, and White-20.
7. Age Groups (by grade completed)
8. All exhibits will be placed by 8pm Wednesday and are not to be taken out until after 4:01 pm Sunday.

### Dept. 205, 4-H Entries

1. Cloverbud (formerly Primaries) 5-7 years
2. Junior 8-10 years
3. Intermediate 11 – 13 years
4. Senior 14 - < 19 years

(Cloverbud members may only participate in DIV 1 and Groom Squad)

### Dept. 255, FFA Entries

1. Novice: Freshman & Sophomore
2. Advanced: Junior & Senior

Champion and Reserve Champions in Fitting & Showing for both 4-H and FFA

- Champion: \$40
- Reserve Champion: \$20

### DIV 1 – Fitting and Showing

Points: Blue 80, Red 50, White 20

To be judged on:

1. Appearance of animal and exhibitor and showing of animal.
2. Walk, trot, stand and turn as directed by judge.
3. Additional tests as directed by judge.

### DIV 2 – Western Games

- All classes will be conducted as indicated in the current rule book: 4-H Contest Guide PNW 574 available through the local Extension Office.
- Exhibitor must enter Fitting and Showing with the horse used in Western Games.
- Games will begin at 9 a.m. Friday. The times for the following events will be used to determine Grand and Reserve Champion in each Class:
  1. Barrel Racing
  2. Pole Bending
  3. Flag Racing
  4. Figure 8 Stake Race
  5. Keyhole Race

### DIV 3 – Educational Displays

Educational Displays and/or posters are entered at the Horse Barns on check-in day, Wednesday, and will be judged in this location as well.

*Class 1:* Individual Poster or Display  
Points: Blue 25, Red 20, White 15

*Class 2:* Group Barn Display  
Points: Blue 35, Red 25, White 15

### DIV 4 – Performance Horse

1. All classes are conducted as indicated in the current rule book "4H Horse Contest Guide PNW 574", available through the local Extension Office.
2. Classes begin at 9 a.m. Thursday.
3. Exhibitors may sign-up for the following classes.
  1. **Bareback Equitation**
  2. **English Equitation** – hunt or saddle seat
  3. **Western Equitation**
  4. **Trail** – course will be set up in main arena. It is the contestant's responsibility to complete the course in allotted time.
5. **Dressage** – See 4-H Dressage Manual PNW 608.

### DIV 5 – Green Horse Intermediate and Seniors Only

Horses shown in green horse cannot be shown in Divisions 2 or 4.

1. For class information, see current Handbook available through the local Extension Office.
2. Horses to be shown Thursday following performance classes.

### DIV 6 – Costume Class

To be shown Friday at 8:30 AM prior to the Western Games.

This division is designed for exhibitor's enjoyment and a chance to show off their creativity and imagination. There will be no premium points; ribbons and special prizes will be awarded. All ages will show together.

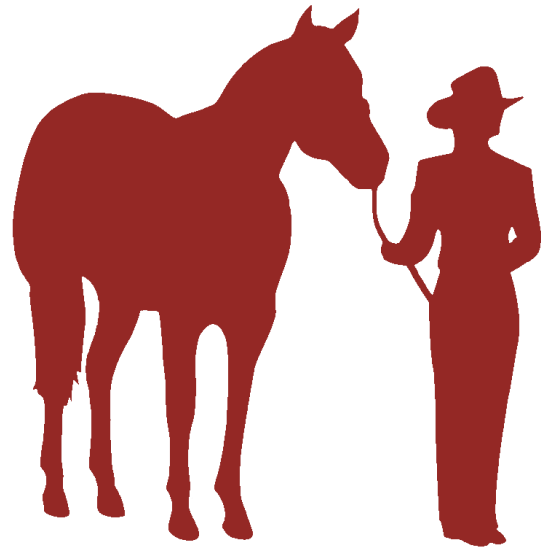
### HORSE GROOM SQUAD Special Awards Given
