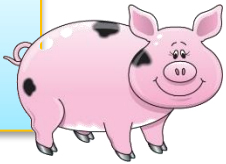

Youth - DIV 1

Points: Blue 60, Red 40, White 20

- **Due to lack of space, all "Lil Squealers" must show a pig that is currently entered as a 4-H/FFA project. They must also have signed consent from the hogs owner attached to the entry form also due on August 1st.**
- This is an open class youth program for ages 4 through 8 years of age who are not eligible for 4-H market at time of Fair.
- Pigs must weigh between 200 and 300 lbs at check in time on Wednesday prior to fair.
- Pig must stay at Fair from Wednesday through Sunday at close of Fair.
- Pig must have health papers at check in on Wednesday.
- Showmen must follow barn rules for taking care of their animal.
- Classes will be judged following fitting and showing requirements.
- Pig will not be sold at the Junior Market stock sale, showman will be responsible for the pigs removal from the fairgrounds at close of Fair.
- If pig is property of a sibling that is shown in 4-H or FFA market divisions and is otherwise eligible to be sold, the older sibling shall be allowed to sell pig as their one market animal.
- Because of the age and need for exhibitors safety, special arrangements will be made for show ring appearances under the guidance of the barn superintendent.

Youth - DIV 1 - Independent Rider

(Youth is able to ride class alone)
Points: Blue 60, Red 40, White 20

Youth - DIV 2 - Helping Hand

(Youth has an adult helper during class)
Points: Blue 50, Red 30, White 15

- This is an open class youth program for ages 4 through 8 years of age who are not eligible for 4-H at time of Fair. Starts at 9am.
- Horses may be hauled in Saturday Morning and hauled out after showing.
- Horses must have health papers at check in on Saturday.
- Showmen must follow barn rules for taking care of their animal.
- Classes will be judged following western equitation.
- Because of the age and need for exhibitors safety, special arrangements will be made for show ring appearances under the guidance of the barn superintendent.
