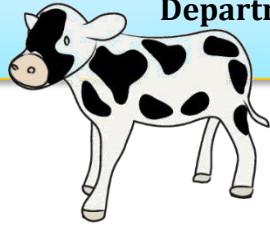

Youth - DIV 6

Points: Blue 75, Red 55, White 35

Open to any youth between 4 and 8 years not eligible to show in 4-H. Steers and heifers may be purebred or crossbred, but not to exceed one year of age. Calves must be size appropriate to exhibitor and exhibitor must be able to safely lead animal.

Showmanship judged on Danish system.

Participation ribbons issued to all exhibitors.

All females over four months must be Brucellosis vaccinated prior to the Fair and display proof thereof.

Class:

1. Showmanship. (Classes will be arranged by each exhibitor's age.)

Youth- DIV 5

Points: Blue 60, Red 40, White 20

1. Junior show persons who have completed the second grade and younger shall be eligible.
2. Goat must be under one year of age

3. Class will be judged 60% on conformation, 40% on fitting and showing.
4. Entrants will be judged in this section and not in competition with other sections in the goat division.
5. Goats to be sold must adhere to all the rules and regulations of the Jr. Livestock Committee.
6. If exhibitor prefers to share a pen with a particular 4H/FFA group or individual, please specify the Club or Chapter number on entry form.

Youth - DIV 2

Points: Blue 75, Red 55, White 35

7. Junior show persons who have completed the second grade and younger shall be eligible.
8. Lamb must be ewe or wether under one year of age. Animals will be weighed in on arrival.
9. Class will be judged 60% on conformation, 40% on fitting and showing.
10. Entrants will be judged in this section and not in competition with other sections in the sheep division.
11. Lambs will be sold according to the owner's wishes (packer or take home.) The packers need's will also be considered. If the animal is intended to be turned to the packer, then the youth and parent must participate in a quality assurance program in correspondence with a 4-H club or FFA Chapter prior to August 1, of current fair year.
