Pigs shall weigh 200 lbs. or more to be entered in the Swine Fitting and Showing at Palouse Empire Fair.

To enter Market classes, weight shall be 240-300 lbs.

#### Division 2 – Market Swine (Barrow or Gilt)

1. All market hogs are to be entered in Class 1. They will be divided into classes according to

weight. The owner shall be present to show or sell his/her animal. Hogs not making weight can only be entered in the Fitting and Showing contest and may not be sold through the auction or to the packer.
