General Rules and Regulations

- Superintendent Reserves the Right to Cancel and or Combine Classes and Activities.
- Entries in 4-H and FFA divisions must be recognized projects in member's care by June 1st of the current year.
- Entry Forms must be signed by club leader or FFA instructor, exhibitor and parent/guardian and mailed by August 1st. They must also include an exhibitor number.
- No Stallions.
- 4H and FFA may not cross entries.
- Premium points will be given to all participants in Fitting and Showing, and one entry in each of the following; Division 2, Division 4, and Division 5, for a total of 4 class entries, but may participate in more.
- All Divisions will be judged according to the danish system, with premium points as follows: Blue- 80, Red-50, and White-20.
- All exhibits will be placed by 8 pm Wednesday and are not to be taken out until after 4:01 pm Sunday.
- Cloverbud members may only participate in Division 1 and Groom Squad.
- Age Groups by grade completed.

Dept. 255, FFA Entries

1. Novice: Freshman & Sophomore

Division 1 – Fitting and Showing

Points Awarded: Blue 80, Red 50, White 20

Rules:

- To be judged on:

- Appearance of animal and exhibitor and showing of animal.
- Walk, trot, stand and turn as directed by judge.
- Additional tests as directed by judge.

Division 2 – Western Games

Points Awarded: Blue 80, Red 50, White 20

Rules:

- All classes will be conducted as indicated in the current rule book: 4-H Contest Guide PNW 574 available through the local Extension Office.
- Exhibitor must enter Fitting and Showing with the horse used in Western Games.
- Games will begin at 9 a.m. Friday. The times for the following events will be used to determine Grand and Reserve Champion in each Class:

2. Pole Bending
3. Flag Racing
4. Figure 8 Stake Race
5. Keyhole Race

Division 3 – Educational Displays

Rules:

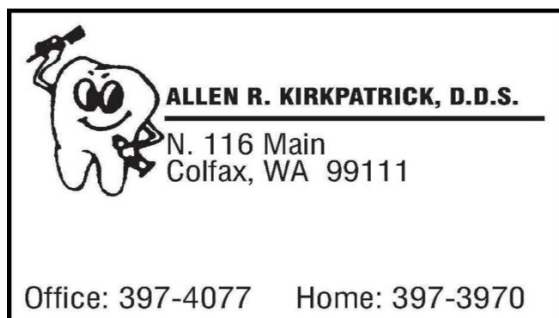
- Intermediate and Seniors Only

- This Division is designed for exhibitor's enjoyment and a chance to show off their creativity and imagination.
- All ages will show together.



Special Contests and Awards

Groom Squad

Points Awarded: Blue 80, Red 50, White 20

Rules:

- To be conducted Sunday, near Old McDonald's Barn at 9:00 a.m.
- The purpose of the "Groom Squad" contest is to provide 4-H and FFA youth an opportunity to demonstrate their ability to work together to groom and prepare a horse for show.
- Competing groom squads will be selected by superintendent and will be composed of members from each age group.
- Rules for the contest will be according to the 4-H Rule Book C1114E.

Saturday Play-Day

Points Awarded: TBA

- Starting Saturday at 10am, in the outdoor arena.
- Play-day is voluntary but points will be awarded to those who participate.
- Games will conclude at lunch time.
- Purpose of the Play-day is to give the 4-H and FFA members a fun activity to do with their horses and other exhibitors (while working on team work, communication, horsemanship skills, etc.).
- Rules will be explained before each game starts.
