Pigs shall weigh 200 lbs. or more to be entered in the Swine Fitting and Showing at Palouse Empire Fair. To enter Market classes, weight shall be 240-300 lbs.

weight. The owner shall be present to show or sell his/her animal. Hogs not making weight can only be entered in the Fitting and Showing contest and may not be sold through the auction or to the packer.
