Superintendent will schedule in 10 minute time slots or as needed. Open to all previously judged 4-H Demonstration Exhibitors. All entries are to pre-register with the Fair Office by August 1st. Department 215 / Division 1 / Class 1. No Exhibit Tag Required.

General Rules and Regulations

In order to enter in the Fair, the exhibitor must participate in the Shooting Sports Competition Day held at the Fairgrounds, date announced through the Extension office in Colfax.

Targets are scored on Competition Day and submitted to the Fair for judging and exhibit. Maimed or ripped targets are subject to disqualification. It is the Exhibitor's responsibility to submit the targets on ENTRY DAY of the Fair. Exhibitor must be enrolled in the 4-H Shooting Sports Program.

ABSOLUTELY NO FIREARMS ALLOWED ON THE GROUNDS DURING FAIR. JUDGES DECISIONS ARE FINAL

General Rules and Regulations

- Any Ag Mechanic display too large to exhibit inside the building must be pre-registered with the Fair Office by August 1st. Fair Management shall determine the most suitable, available location for outside displays.
- Exhibits shall have been completed during the past year.
- Exhibits shall be examples of useful farm, agriculture, mechanical or ornamental projects.
- Fair Entry Date: Wednesday of Fair week between 1p.m. and 9 p.m. Exhibits will be judged Thursday.
- All 4-H projects shall have complete documentation of work, starting photos,

receipts, time involved and list of sponsors for project submitted.

- Superintendent will check each project after it is entered to determine project class entry.
- Wood projects will be judged on workmanship, complication of project and construction of same.
