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### WASHINGTON YOUTH LIVESTOCK/ANIMAL PROGRAM COMMITMENT TO EXCELLENCE

AS ADOPTED BY THE PALOUSE EMPIRE FAIR

- I believe that participation in the Washington Youth Livestock/Animal Programs should demonstrate my own knowledge, ability and skill as a feeder, manager, and exhibitor of livestock/animals.
- I will do my own work to the full extent I am capable and otherwise will only accept advice and support from others.
- I will not use or allow to be used abusive, fraudulent or illegal practices in the feeding, fitting and showing of my animal(s).
- I will read, understand, and follow the rules without exception, of all livestock/animal shows in which I am a participant and ask that my parents and the supervisor of my project will do the same.
- My livestock/animal project is an example of how to accept what life has to offer, both good and bad, and how to live with the outcome.
- I realize that I am responsible for:
  - Demonstrating strong moral character as an example to others.
  - The proper care, and safe humane treatment of my animals.
  - The production of high quality, safe, and wholesome food.
  - I consent to having my animal(s) subjected to drug/substance testing.
- **I UNDERSTAND FAILURE TO ABIDE BY THE RULES OF THE PALOUSE EMPIRE FAIR WILL RESULT IN THE FOLLOWING:**
  - Step 1: A verbal warning by Superintendent to Exhibitor of inappropriate behavior/actions;
  - Step 2: Holding of Fair premium check with Superintendent discretion in offering Exhibitor a chance to correct problem:
  - Step 3: Removal of animal & Exhibitor from participation in Livestock Sale, livestock related activities, and removal of animal from grounds.
